A. School Board Members and Attorney

1. School Board Member and Alternate to Serve on the Legislative Committee as the FSBA Legislative Liaison (SMF #28)

Motion by Chapman, seconded by Neves, to approve Ginger Littleton as the FSBA Legislative Liaison and Ryan Neves as the Alternate. Motion unanimously approved.

2. Reappointment of Arthur Cullen to Serve on the Charter School Review Committee – **NEVES** (SMF #29)

Motion by Neves, seconded by Chapman, to approve. Motion unanimously approved.

3. Revenue Anticipation Note, Series 2018, Extension of Maturity Date (SMF #30)

Franklin Harrison stated it is required to extend the maturity of this 5 year note annually. It is \$5 million for security upgrades required at all of the schools.

Motion by Littleton, seconded by Neves, to approve. Motion unanimously approved.

4. Enforcement of Purchase and Sale Contract (SMF #31)

Harrison explained that this is property next to Bay High School that the District offered to purchase as is for its appraisal value plus 10%. The owners of the property signed the contract but failed to show at closing. He would like a vote on whether to pursue enforcing the contract.

Motion by Littleton, seconded by Neves, to approve. Motion approved 3 - 1 with Chapman voting no.

B. Superintendent

- 1. Request to Advertise School Board Policy
- **2.1.** Request to Approve SRD Contracts (SMF #32)

Moss stated that this is a 2-year contract. The Superintendent shared the Sheriff is asking for a 5% increase, keep 2 SRDs at Rutherford/ Everitt combination school, and split the New Horizons position that was paid through a grant that was not renewed.

Motion by Neves, seconded by Chapman, to approve. Motion unanimously approved.

C. Assistant Superintendent for Teaching and Learning Services

1. English Language Arts Curriculum 2019-20 (SMF #33)

Neves had some concerns about the timing. New standards will be coming next year from DOE. Susan Ross stated this is a gap year, possibly 2-year gap. K-8 teachers use planning time trying to find resources. Susan Farrar stated this is a sister to Eureka Math and aligned to the standards. Denise Kelley shared that the district is out of workbooks and this curriculum will be up for adoption.

Motion by Littleton, seconded by Chapman, to approve. Motion approved 3 - 1 with Neves voting no.

This position requires the ability to speak at least 2 languages and knowledge of interventions.

d. Director of Recovery and FEMA Liaison

This position will work with the Principals for documentation and being a liaison with the Haggerty Group. Littleton questioned the requirement of Educational Leadership and hold a Florida Professional Educator Certificate to work with FEMA. She asked that requirement of Educational Leadership be removed and completely remove #3.

Motion by Littleton to revise and advertise, seconded by Neves, to approve. Motion unanimously approved.
