- 7.3 Teachers may send disruptive students to the office to maintain effective discipline in the classroom. Prior to sending disruptive students to the office, the teacher will endeavor to achieve correction of student misbehavior. Teachers sending students to the office will either notify office staff by phone or ensure the student is supervised on his/her way to the office. The student shall not return to the classroom for the remainder of the class session if secondary or for a period of 30-45 minutes if elementary. The teacher shall not be responsible for maintaining records of student discipline referrals. In order to ensure maximum student safety, appropriate disciplinary consequences, appropriate student supports and timely dispositions, teachers must:
 - A. Complete the office referral in the District's FOCUS platform as soon as possible without affecting instruction.
 - B. Document previous intervention attempts, strategies, resources, or parent contacts related to an ongoing disciplinary concern within the Student Tab of the District's FOCUS platform.
 - C. Only the District FOCUS platform will be used for student documentation.
