WHAT IS NEW IN THE BAY DISTRICT CONSTRUCTION CAREER PATHWAYS

PREPARING STUDENTS FOR LOCAL JOBS

Bay District School's Construction Career Pathways are expanding opportunities for their students. At **Arnold High School the Construction** Career Pathway will be adding a "Heavy Equipment" focus which will allow students to earn an OSHA Heavy **Equipment Certification and practice** what they learn on the new CAT Simulators. They should be delivered, installed and ready to operate by the 2nd semester. The first simulator is a G4-Track Type Tractor that will give students opportunities to learn skills like slot dozing, ripping and back filling. The second simulator is a Hydraulic Excavator which will

provide students skills in raking the green, trenching, bench loading, setting trench boxes and pipes among other skills. The simulators give students immediate feedback and reports. They come with 43" monitors so students can "see" the tasks they are performing and will receive individual feedback on their skills and accuracy.

Rutherford High School will be adding a Welding building to their

Construction Career Pathway. This building should be up and ready for students by the 2nd semester if the weather will cooperate! The building will feature open access joining the present Construction Lab to the Welding Lab. Students will work on welding simulators and then progress to working with welders in welding booths.

Both of these programs will provide opportunities to graduate from high school and go directly to work or to continue their education at GCSC, FSU or Haney Technical Center.


