POSSIBLE CAREER PATHWAY -CRIMINAL JUSTICE OPERATIONS

A Criminal Justice Operations Career Pathway provides coherent and rigorous content aligned with challenging academic standards and relevant technical knowledge and skills needed to prepare for further education and careers in the Law, Public Safety and Security career cluster. The courses in this pathway are Criminal Justice Operations 1-3 and a fourth course focusing on the skills needed by a Public Service Officer or a Certified Legal Assistant or in Code Enforcement.

A teacher who is a Florida Certified Law Enforcement Officer or Public Service Officer or Corrections Officer with 6 years of full-time (or the equivalent in part-time experience) occupational experience may teach in this pathway. Exciting events in this career pathway are Law Days, Moot Court, Emergency Planning Activities and more. The certification that students in this career pathway will have the opportunity to earn is the "911 Public Safety Telecommunicator." If you have students that are interested in any area of criminal justice, this is a great career pathway to consider.
