In 2020-21, there were 467,137 participants in career and technical education (CTE) in Florida. Of the students reporting as male or female, 51.0 percent of secondary CTE participants were male, and 49.0 percent were female. ~ Florida PCRN State Profile

I wanted to take a minute to review the amazing progress we have made together and to thank you for all that you have done. It is truly an honor to work for such dedicated and focused individuals doing what is right for students. Thank you for the wonderful memories I have for the last 6+ years.

When CTE in Bay District Schools began in 2011 we reported 61 CAPE Certifications and earned \$46,791. When I arrived in 2017 we reported 988 Certifications for \$372,289. This year your students earned 2,097 Certifications and \$648,575.00 I wanted to share with you that you are the ones that made that happen!!! We also had in 2017 a "Go Daddy.Com website that was not attached or advertised to parents and students, but today we have a Bay District School Website that is updated and by which we disseminate information to our administration, parents and students. If you want to know what Career Pathways are available at a given school, you can find that on the professional Bay District School's website. In 2017 we had no marketing materials for our CTE Programs, no logo and no Pathway Materials to give to parents. Today, we have a logo.
