### Monitoring your child's progress and attendance

Your child's daily grades, progress reports, report cards, attendance, and state and local assessment results are all available 24/7 in Parent Portal. To access it on your phone, download the Bay District Schools' App available in your App store. Keep your FOCUS/Parent Portal updated with your current contact information. If you are not able to access Parent Portal, contact your child's school for assistance or to schedule an appointment.

### State, District, and School Report Cards

<u>Edudata.fldoe.org</u> is Florida's Education Information Portal. It provides parents access to information about Florida's PK-12 students and staff in a variety of formats including graphs, tables, and maps. Information includes: district and school grades; student performance by subgroups; graduation rates; demographics; teachers' qualifications; school quality, climate, and safety; and readiness to start school results.
