Throughout the year, I've had the opportunity to witness unwavering excellence across every corner of Bay District Schools ... in every classroom, on every campus, on our buses, in our maintenance department, and throughout the district office. From our most recent meetings, several key themes stood out:

At the secondary level (grades 6-12), our students brought forward several ideas that we are excited to begin refining and implementing for the upcoming school year:

• We will launch a significant initiative to ensure that all students understand how to access the services provided by our professional school counselors, empowering them to make informed decisions about their educational and career paths. This includes a targeted outreach to middle school students, and their

parents/guardians, to ensure they understand the opportunities and responsibilities presented by tackling high-school-level coursework in middle school.

- We will begin developing an expanded menu of free, optional test preparation sessions outside regular school hours, including weekends, to better prepare students for state and national assessments.
- We will expand college application support to make the process smoother, more personalized, and accessible for all students, regardless of background or circumstance.

At the elementary level, we are also proud to build on the strong foundation laid this year by focusing on key initiatives to better prepare our youngest learners for the future:

- We will increase opportunities for Career and Technical Education (CTE) exposure across all elementary grades, helping students start dreaming even earlier about the wide variety of careers available to them..
- We will continue to strengthen character education through programs like the Leader in Me and the Ron Clark Academy House System, equipping students with the essential soft skills, such as teamwork, leadership, and resilience, they need to succeed in life.
- We will also expand family engagement opportunities at the elementary level, providing more hands-on workshops and events to equip parents and guardians with tools to support their child's academic, emotional, and social development.

There is so much to celebrate, and even more to look forward to! I am filled with pride, gratitude, and optimism as we wrap up this year. Thank you for everything you have done to make a difference in the lives of our students and families.
